Authentic Welsh

Guide Megan Klingensmith dresses the part with 1700s Welsh garb Sunday for a Nationality Room dedication on the third floor of the Cathedral of Learning at the University of Pittsburgh. The room, the 27th ethnic classroom at the university, is patterned after the Pen-rhiw Chapel at St. Fagans National History Museum near Cardiff, Wales.
